Disabled Access Policy

Disabled Access Policy:

1. Employees, pupils and visitors with physical disabilities are welcome at Fyling Hall. Because of the nature of the school site, built on a hillside among woods, access to some areas may present a challenge.
2. The school will endeavour to do all that it can to provide access to parts of the school site as necessary. Escorts and 'wheelchair pushers' will be made available to help where required.
3. Visits and advice from the Area Disability Access Officer are welcomed.
4. The Headmaster will review access to buildings and other areas on a termly basis, and make recommendations to the premises committee of the Governing body on any changes that may be advised.
5. Where visitors have specific needs to ensure access, the school will endeavour to provide the necessary facilities provided sufficient notice is given.
6. Helpful comments are welcomed from all visitors; employees, pupils and others associated with Fyling Hall, and should be directed in the first instance to the Secretary, Fyling Hall School.
