

| Subjects | |
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| English | We will be going through your comprehension and continuing with our sci-fi unit. Work will be in assignments and you will have a week to do it. Catch up is 10am on Thursday morning. |
| Maths | The week should start with Numeracy Ninjas, week22, session 2. (10 mins including marking). Then Skills Check which should be completed, marked and uploaded to Teams (30 minutes approx). Work in exercise books this week will be on decimals (30-40 minutes approx). Don't forget MyMaths is still running (20 minutes approx). Any overdue should be caught up. |
| Science | We are looking at the concept of Energy. What is it? How is it transferred? Where can we get more of it? How can we stop heat escaping from a room, or keep a drink cool and stop heat getting in? These questions and more this week. 90 minutes required. |
| Geography | Thank you to all of you who had a guess about who committed the crime! If you have not yet please send it to me before I reveal the culprits. Complete crime mapping assignment. We will discuss an example on Friday before you attempt to complete your own map. This will take you about an hour. |
| History | This week pupils will continue their look at the Black Death in the Middle Ages. They will be required to read the accompanying materials and complete the questions and tasks set. This work should take them approximately 1 hour. |
| French | This week we will continue with our theme of 'My house.' You will be finding the meaning of some vocabulary to do with items in your bedroom and learning some prepositions to describe where things are. There will be a number of short tasks again which should take no more than 25 to 30 mins each (overall around 1h30 mins total) There will be a video/audio catch up at 11.00 on Wednesday morning. |
| ICT | Create your own maze game today using the skills you have learnt over the previous weeks. Choose your own theme, background and sprite and make it move around the maze using the arrow keys. Display a message when the game ends. Full instructions in assignment. Meeting 11.00. Deadline Wed 13/05. |
| German | This week, year 7 will work on weather vocabulary, the "verb 2nd" rule and activities. Pupils make sentences like "I dance because it is raining". They also have to make a poster with 3 of their favourite sentences. In session 3 pupils will combine the verb 2nd rule with the weather conditions, making sentences like "On Monday it is sunny." Also, I would like them to work on Duolingo. All work apart from the poster is to be finished on the word documents and handed in by Monday, 4pm. I will have marked it by Tuesday 9pm. Our video tutorial is on Wednesday, 10am. |
| Drama | Set Monday (due Thursday): Taking the notes that you have been writing over the past two weeks, you are going to write a review about the Aladdin performance, choosing whether to review the performers or the designers of the show. You are expected to write this in full sentences and in as much detail as possible. There is more guidance and a writing structure for your review in your assignments area, use this to guide you through. Your work should be submitted by Thursday 7th May to the Assignments area and I will be providing feedback within the week. There will be one group chat at 1:30pm during your Monday slot to ask any questions about the Drama and Music work. I will be available on chat during your lesson time (Monday 1-3) and also my twilight session (Wednesday 4pm-6pm). |
| Music | Set Monday (due Thursday): Choose a new letter from 'Musical Alphabet Challenge' and complete the task associated with that letter. The tasks vary from listening, to research, to practical and even composing, try to do something different each week (e.g. if you did performing last week, do some listening this week). You will be completing all of your work in the Teams Assignments area (where you will find more details), but this task should take roughly 40 minutes to complete, there is extension work if you finish too quickly and what to challenge yourself. Your work should be submitted by Thursday 7th May to the Assignments area (as either a photo, video or document) and I will be aiming to provide feedback by the time you have your next lesson. There will be one group chat at 1:30pm during your Monday slot to ask any questions about the Drama and Music work. I will be available on chat during your lesson time (Monday 1-3) and also my twilight session (Wednesday 4pm-6pm). |
| Art | To create an Artist research page based around the artist Rosalind Monks. Think of an exciting pattern that you can decorate the page with which would represent the artist's style – eg. Doodle designs. You should research this artist yourselves and find out information about her and find images of her work. You should then write your opinion of her work – do you like/dislike it? Why? You should then complete a response drawing of one piece of her work. This is where you choose one of her artworks and draw your own version of this. This is a bigger task than previous so you have two weeks to complete - this is the second week. It shouldn't take more than 2 hrs to complete but I suggest starting it in lesson time and judge how long you need to finish. Work due on Tuesday 19th May. |
